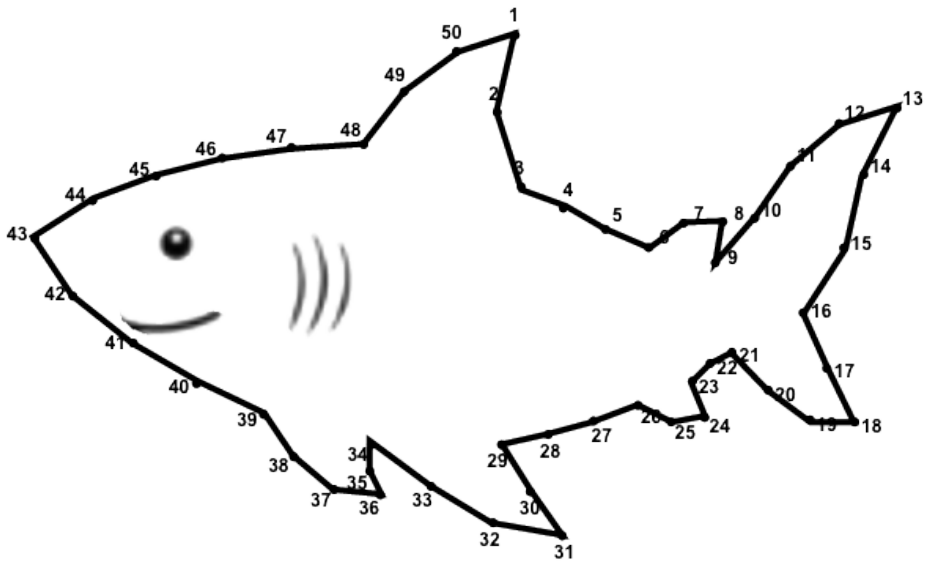


PUZZLE PAGE

Follow the lead of the numbers to complete the puzzle!



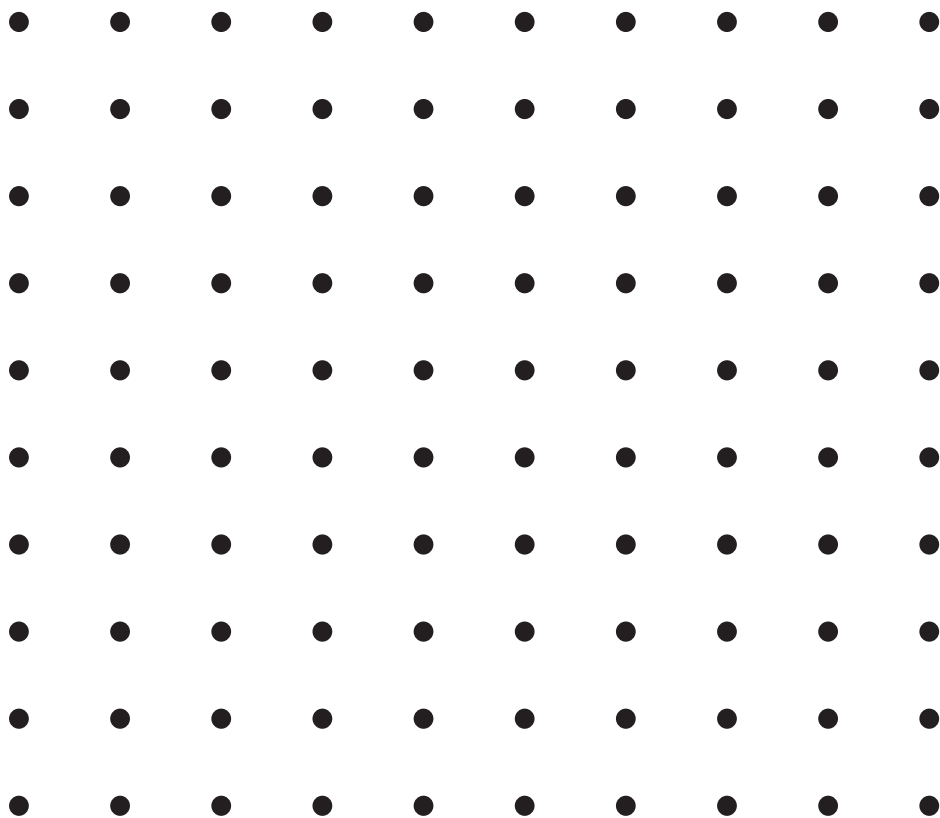
REBUS PUZZLES

Each of the boxes below represents a phrase. The only rule is that there are no rules so think outside of the box, and don't forget to have fun!



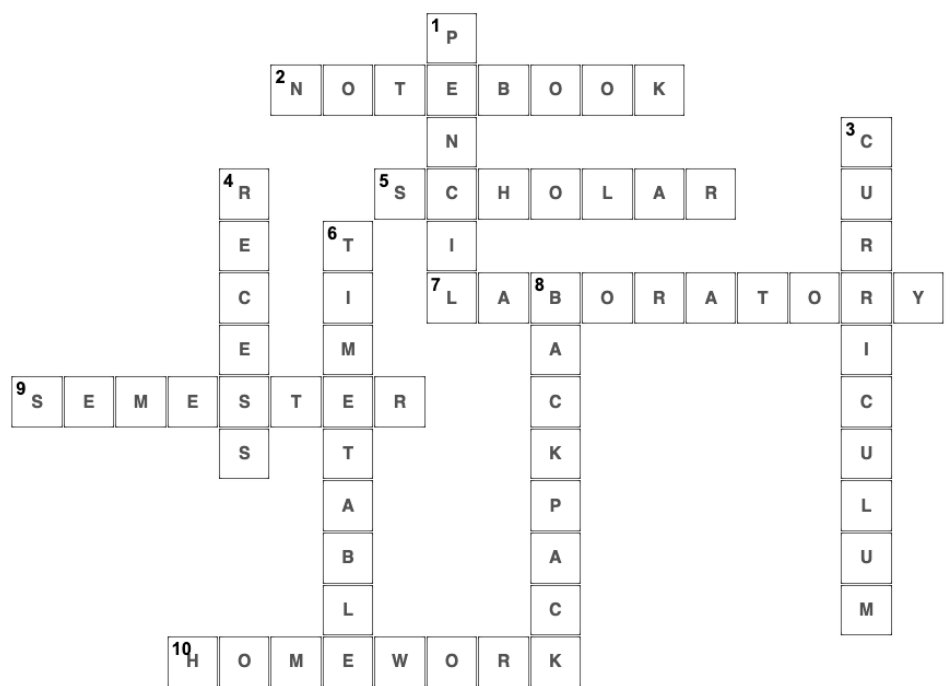
DOTS TO BOXES

Two players take turns drawing a single horizontal or vertical line between adjacent dots on a grid. The player who draws the fourth line of a 1x1 square claims the square by putting their initial inside it and gets to take another turn. The game ends when no more lines can be drawn, and the player with the most claimed squares wins.
